



## INTERNATIONAL JUDGING SYSTEM

### Judging licence system

<b>1. Licence judging test</b> Gives you right to act: as judges instructor (TC decision), as a head judge and in the Superior Jury Judging Skills course of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics
Requirements: Level 2 judging card at least 2 (two) years. Wide national judging experience. Minimum 5 (five) international competitions that TC has approved (A-cat.) after level 2 exam.
<b>2. Licence judging test</b> Gives you right to act: as a national judges instructor, as an international judge Deep techniques of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics course
Requirements: Level 3 judging card at least 2 (two) years. Minimum 4 (four) International competitions that TC has approved (A-cat.) after level 3 exam.
<b>3. Licence judging test</b> Gives you right to act: as an international judge Exercises and basics of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics techniques National judging experience

- ❑ Judge can renew the licence in the international judging course
- ❑ Judging licence system would contain totally about 100 - 130 hours.  
For example

- 3. level: 15 h judging course + distance exercises and basics of AGG techniques 20 h
- 2. level: 15 h judging course + distance exercises and deep technical course of AGG 20 h
- 1. level: 15 h judging course + distance exercises and judging skills course 20 h

#### Licence is into force

Judge must evaluate minimum 1 competition (minimum category B) in one year time period after passing the judges exam (level). Otherwise the judging licence is not into force / get's no confirmation.

If there are no competition in 1 year period (counted from well passed judges licence exam), judge must participate for the new course and make a new exam.

#### Substitution of AGG judging licence

International judging cards can not be replaced for ex. by a card of some other sport and experience or anything similar but everyone has to get through courses and exams of IFAGG judging licence system.
